1981 - 1982: Rocky Mountain Women's Institute, Denver, Colorado. Stipend and studio space.

1975: Hill Family Foundation, Fargo, North Dakota. \$1500 to fund oral history of the Red River Valley as remembered by women who were the descendants of original pioneer settlers. Final project was a slide show with narration and recorded conversations with women. All of the interviewees were 80+ years old. This program is now in archives at Minnesota Historical Society and North Dakota Historical Society.
